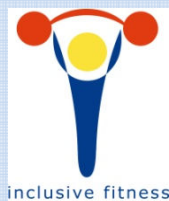

Background



- LDA funded project
- £4,250 worth of services
- Ends March 2013
- Mayor's Legacy Plan – “A Sporting Future for London”

Progress to date



- Over 80 facilities identified
- 1 Action Plan a week
- Working with: GLA, LDA, Sport England, Host Boroughs, BUCS, LOCOG

Benefits of Accreditation



- Support thorough accreditation process
- Support of influential partners
- Links with Disabled People's Organisations and Disability Charities
- Outreach Plan with support from Strategic Development Officer

Process of Accreditation



Access Audit

- Project Officer visits the Applicant Facility to assess current accessibility or does this from architect's plans.

Action Plan

- Document containing all necessary adaptations required to achieve IFI Mark Accreditation discussed.

Outreach Plan

- Strategic Development Officer supports Applicant Facility to produce an Outreach Plan.

Sign Off

- Project Officer ensures all the points of the Action Plan have been completed.

Supporting Facilities
